



## Overnight Summer Camp Packing List

### **Please Bring:**

- Swimsuit (modest, one-piece suits for females or modest "tankinis", no tight fitting suits for males)
- Towels (for swimming & showering)
- 2 Pairs of Shoes (1 pair must be supportive sneakers for running around)
- Sleeping bag and pillow or other twin size bedding
- Clothing for seven days (including long pants, shirts, sweater for cooler weather)
- Dress Clothes for "Fancy Friday"
- Bible
- Notebook
- Pen or Pencil
- Sunscreen SPF 15+
- Insect Repellent (tick & misquito)
- Flashlight
- Old-school watch (no smart or screen watches)
- Toothbrush and Toothpaste
- Soap, and Shampoo
- Camera (optional)
- White T-Shirt or Pillow Case for Tie-Dye (optional)
- Approximately \$30 for Taste & See purchases (gifts, souvenirs, clothing, snacks)

*All clothing must be modest and appropriate. Shirts must reach at least 1-inch below the waist of pants. Shorts and skirts should come down to the fingertips. Pants must be worn pulled up to the waist.*

### **Please Do Not Bring Any Electronics, Examples include:**

- Radios
- All types of music players and headphones
- Smart or screen watches
- Electronic games or handheld game systems
- Smart Phones
- Laptop computers or tablets
- Digital cameras that have WiFi

*Please Note: Any electronics found in a camper's possession will be taken and returned upon camper pick-up on Saturday.*

### **Other Prohibited Items:**

- Tobacco in any form, including vaping, e-cigarettes, etc.
- Alcohol
- Illegal drugs or non-prescribed medications, including marijuana in any form
- Inappropriate reading material
- Immodest clothing, including spaghetti straps, halter tops, tube tops, backless tops, short shorts, and low hanging trousers
- Clothing with potentially offensive words or graphics
- Fireworks or other explosive materials
- Firearms
- Knives
- Items that may be perceived as a weapon

*We do not allow smart phone use at camp and encourage campers to unplug and have a screen-free week. Please have your camper leave their electronics at home*
